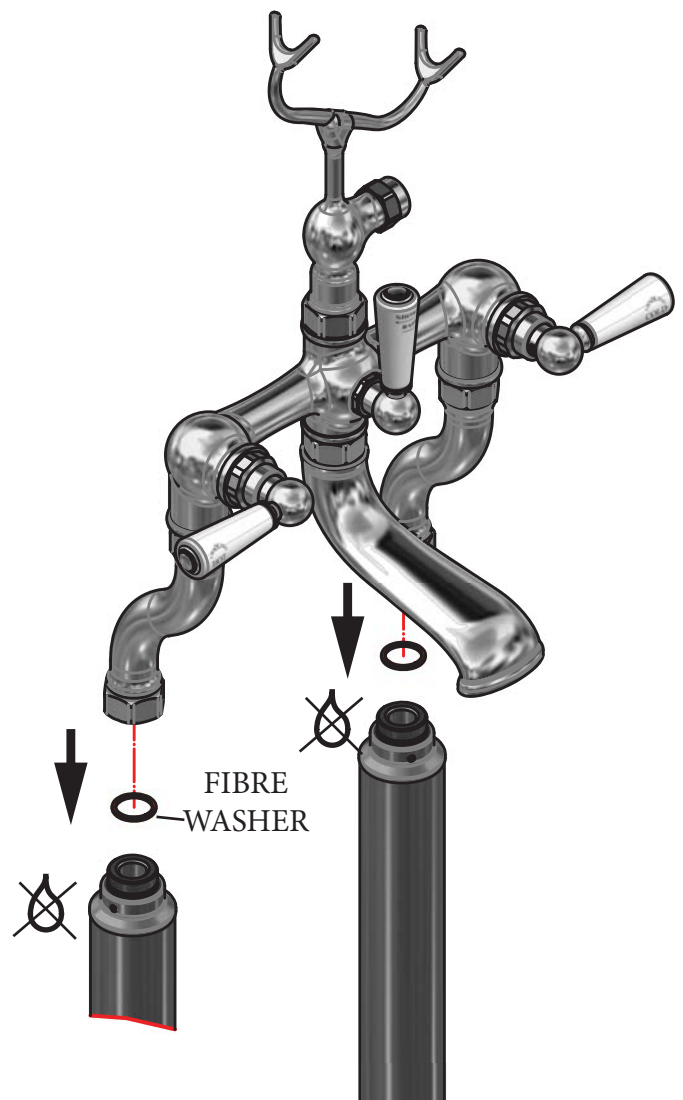

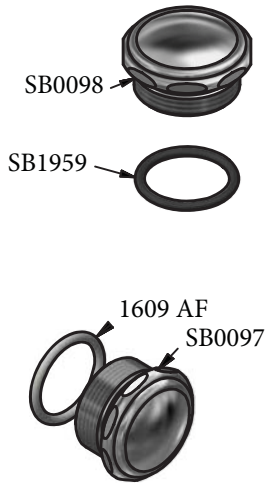
ENSURE HOLE IN TUBE
LINES UP WITH ISOLATION VALVE



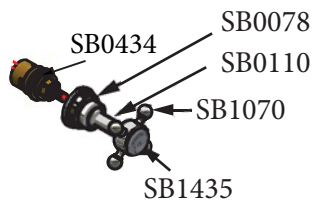
